

FOR - SINCE

Woodward

I have been

for 4 years.

living in Japan

I have been living in Japan since 2012.



FOR

+ period of time + number + time word

When we measure the duration of something or how long it lasts.

It has a start point and an end point and can be used in different tenses.

- I studied English in Ireland for 2 years.
- I will be there for around two months.
- We have been married for 14 years.

for ten minutes for eight hours for five days for six months for three years for two centuries

FOR

SINCE + starting point + a time / a date

When something started in the past and continues until now.

Since is mostly used in the present perfect and perfect progressive tense.

- He hasn't eaten since 7 o'clock.
- I have been working here since June.
- We have been married since 2002.

since 8 o'clock since Monday since February since 1982
