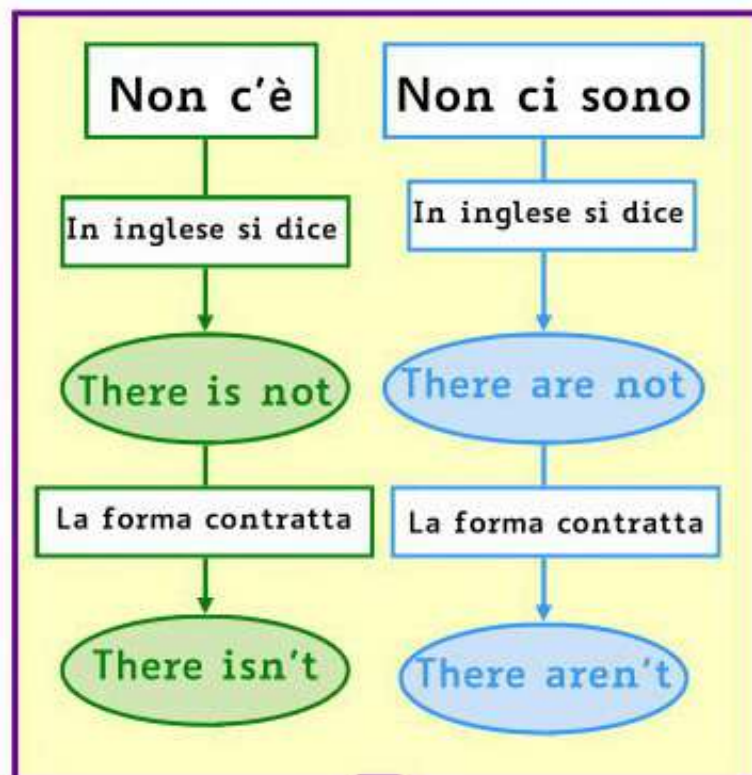
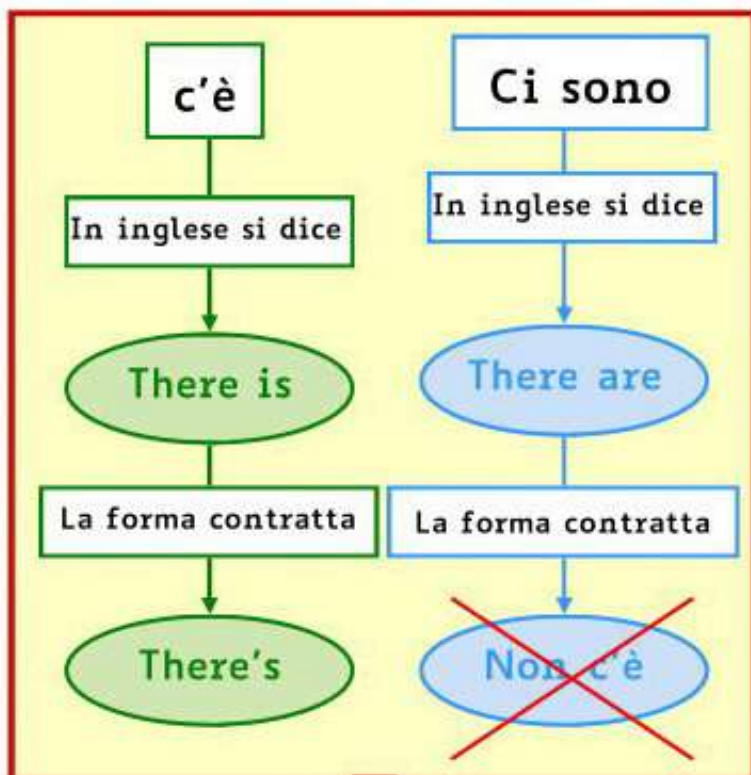


USO DI THERE IS / THERE ARE

AFFERMATIVE

ESEMPIO:

C'è una scrivania nella stanza
There's a desk in the bedroom

Nelle frasi
NEGATIVE

ESEMPIO:

Non c'è una scrivania nella stanza
There isn't a desk in the bedroom

SE NON SI CONOSCE LA QUANTITA' DELLE COSE SI USANO SOME E ANY



There is - There are

Meaning: To say that something exists (or doesn't exist)

AFFIRMATIVE

There **is** + singular noun

There **is** a book on the desk.

There **are** + plural noun

There **are** books on the desk.

There **is** + uncountable noun

There **is** some milk in the fridge.

NEGATIVE

There **isn't** + singular noun

There **isn't** a pen on the table.

There **aren't** + plural noun

There **aren't** any pens here.

There **isn't** + uncountable noun

There **isn't** any juice in the fridge.

QUESTIONS

There **is** a cat on the chair.

There **are** cats on the sofa.

Is there a cat on the chair?

Are there cats on the sofa?

How many + plural noun + **are there** ... ?

How many students **are there** in your class?

How many days **are there** in February?

CONTRACTIONS

There's = There is

There's not = There is not

There isn't = There is not

There aren't = There are not

There is There are

le espressioni **there is** e **there are**
corrispondono all'italiano **c'è** e **ci sono**

Forma affermativa

	forma intera	forma contratta
singolare	There is	There's
plurale	There are	---

*There's a computer in my bedroom.
There are three bedrooms in the house.*

There's è la forma **contratta** di **there is**,
mentre
non esiste la forma contratta di **there are**

There is (There's) si **usa** con un sostantivo singolare

There is viene anche usato per un elenco di cose quando il primo sostantivo è singolare

There's a TV and a computer in my classroom.

There are si **usa** con un sostantivo plurale

Forma negativa

	forma intera	forma contratta
singolare	There is not	There isn't
plurale	There are not	There aren't

la forma negativa contratta si forma mettendo **-n't** dopo **is** e **are**

*There isn't a computer in my bedroom.
There aren't two bathrooms in our flat.*

Forma interrogativa e risposte brevi

	forma interrogativa	risposte brevi
singolare	Is there ...?	Yes, there is. No, there isn't.
plurale	Are there ...?	Yes, there are. No, there aren't.

la forma interrogativa si forma mettendo prima **Is** o **Are** poi **there** seguito dal resto della frase.

Solo le risposte brevi negative hanno la forma contratta

non confondere le forme di **be**, con quelle dell'**aggettivo possessivo** e di **there are**:
Their = il loro

They're = (Loro) sono

There are = Ci sono
